However, African states recently agreed the Tripartite Free Trade Area (TFTA), a massive free-trade agreement that would link three of the communities - COMESA, the EAC and SADC - into a single 'Cape-to-Cairo' free-trade zone. The 26 TFTA countries contribute some 60% of the continent's GDP.

The African Free Trade Zone is a free trade zone announced at the EAC-SADC-COMESA Summit on 22 October 2008 by the heads of Southern African Development Community, the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa and the East African Community.
