For free-motion quilting, the feed dog of the sewing machine is deactivated so that you can move the fabric layers to be sewn back and forth manually in all directions.

Most batting requires quilting at least 8 or 10 inches, but I'm going to recommend you overachieve a little bit: quilt every 4 inches. I know it sounds crazy, but when I spend so much time piecing a quilt, I want it to last through many many washes and cuddles.When I quilt lines at 4 inches apart at the most, I know my quilt sandwich is safe and secure and I sleep better at night.
