About 1 in 10 breech babies have some sort of neurological reason. A more common reason for full-term babies is what bodyworkers might call a " muscle imbalance. ". Studies show that there is a higher rate of low thyroid function in mothers of breech babies. This may show a metabolic connection to the fetal position.

Breech Baby: Causes, Complications, and Turning

Breech is very common in early pregnancy, and by 36–37 weeks of pregnancy most babies will turn into the head-first position. If your baby remains breech, it does not usually mean that you or your baby have any problems. Turning your baby into the head-first position so that you can have a vaginal delivery is a safe option.

But if your baby is breech, it means he's poised to come out buttocks or feet first. When labor begins at 37 weeks or later, nearly 97 percent of babies are set to come out headfirst. Most of the rest are breech. (In rare cases, a baby will be sideways in the uterus with his shoulder, back, or arm presenting first – this is called a transverse lie.)

Breech presentation is associated with uterine and congenital abnormalities, and has a significant recurrence risk. Term babies presenting by the breech have worse outcomes than cephalic presenting babies, irrespective of the mode of delivery.

Breech means that your baby is in a bottom-down position. It's usually a temporary position during your third trimester. If your baby is breech, you may feel discomfort under your ribs and become breathless as your baby's head presses up under your diaphragm. You may also feel some sharp kicks to your bladder.
