Crash-cart preparedness - Joint Commission

1. The responsible person will complete the Code Cart Daily Checklist including date/sign/initial upon completion of procedure. STEP ACTION KEY POINTS 1 Code carts will be plugged in and secured with a breakaway RED OR YELLOW numbered seal when not in use. Replacement of numbered seal can be obtained from pharmacy

Title: Checking Procedure, Cart Locations, Equipment ...

The crash cart checklist must be attached to the outside of the cart so that it is unmovable but easily seen. It should also be laminated in order to maintain its integrity. Again, as the hospital or department using the crash carts decides to add or remove items, the crash cart checklist must be updated immediately to reflect the changes.

The emergency crash cart inventory checklist covers everything that should be included, such as medications, emergency crash defibrillator equipment, patient monitors and more. Once the crash cart inventory has been completed each day, users can sign off on the list electronically.

Our crash cart is fairly sufficient: suction equipment (of course there are nights when we have to go in search of a cannister when we are checking off on the crash cart!!!) and the tubing and accessories to go with it, a portable O2 tank with non-rebreather; CPR board, ambu bag, mouth shields, oral airway, unopened box of gloves, tape, sterile bandages, scissors, hazardous materials bags, a small bottle of normal saline and packages of lubricant and betadine.

Would you please share a template of a crash cart daily log sheet? I would like to see what the O2 cylinder volume is when in a crash cart. The checklist for a crashcart is different from facility to facility because it lists the equipment in your cart. An oxygen cylinder in a crash cart should be maintained always greater than half full.

Crash Cart — Recently Asked Questions

The ACLS crash cart guidelines simply state the carts should be “ in sufficient number to meet potential care needs. ” Depending on the number of patients the healthcare facility cares for on any given day, on any given floor, or in any given unit, the number of crash carts may vary.

The ACLS Crash Cart Requirements: What You Need to Know

Designate licensed personnel to perform scheduled daily inventories of your crash cart supplies for expiration and availability while registering compliance on an approved checklist. Download a sample inventory list. Ensure functionality, accessibility, and security of all Medical Equipment, crash cart drugs, and supply inventory.
