On 21 July 2020, the government confirmed its intention to introduce a £95,000 cap on exit payments in the public sector. The change allows these payments to be recovered from highly paid public servants moving between jobs. The change was first consulted on in August 2015 and resurrected in April 2019 with a further consultation.

### Employment Law Updates UK - CIPD

There are three important changes to written statements, which will apply from April 6th 2020: All workers employed on or after 6th April 2020 will be entitled to a written statement of employment particulars. Employees and workers must be provided with their written statement on or before their first day of employment.

### Employment Law UK & Employment Law Advice - Acas

From 6 April 2020, it's been made easier to request an information and consultation agreement. A minimum of 2%, rather than 10% of employees (or at least 15 people), in workplaces with 50 employees or more can request a formal agreement to be informed and consulted about workplace matters.
