(One cause of a crack is a hoof abscess--see below--which breaks out through the coronet band at the top of the hoof, creating a weak spot in the hoof wall that must be attended to as it grows out.) If you notice a crack in your horse's hoof, call your farrier and describe its location and size so he can decide whether it needs attention now or can wait until the next regular shoeing.

Ten Hoof Care Tips to Help Keep Your Horse's Hooves ...

Cup your horse's hoof. Once your horse shifts her weight to the other foot, move your hand from the horse's shoulder or rear to the front of her ankle on the foot you're trying to lift. Gently cup the hoof in your hand. Then release the hoof, praise your horse, and offer her a treat.
