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Occupational exposure. Occupational exposure to MOCA may occur through inhalation, ingestion and skin absorption: because of its low vapour, it can be inhaled as a dust when processed in a dry form; poor personal hygiene can allow contamination of the hands and ingestion while eating or smoking; however, the most likely route of exposure is thought to be by skin absorption after contact with contaminated surfaces (Linch et al., 1971; Clapp et al., 1991; Lowry & Clapp, 1992). Several of the tools that hairdressers worked with on a daily basis – hand-held hairdryers and hood-style hairdryers – once contained toxic levels of asbestos. As with most other asbestos-containing products, the hairdryers contained asbestos to protect the internal parts from overheating and catching on fire.

Hairdressers - Asbestos Risks, Products, Exposure & Lawsuits

Hairdressers today have an increased risk of developing occupational skin diseases due to exposure to skin irritants and sensitizers (van der Walle, 2000; Uter et al., 2003). Hair cosmetic products such as hair colours, permanent wave solutions and bleaches can cause contact allergy and the extensive wet work itself can cause irritant contact dermatitis.

Background: Hairdressers are exposed to various irritating chemicals during work. Objective: This study was designed as a case-control study to evaluate the risk of developing obstructive lung disease in relation to occupational exposures in hairdressers. 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the general population, using a validated questionnaire for occupational respiratory disease, to compare the prevalence of ...

non-dominant hands of hairdressers have significantly higher overall wrist velocity than those of barbers ($p < 0.005$). Analytical results suggest that the relatively higher force exertion and wrist velocity of female hairstylists combined with prolonged exposure may account for the higher rate of hand/wrist

Hairdressers are exposed to many hazardous agents in the workplace, including vapours, solvents, perfumes and dusts [1–7], capable of causing adverse health effects, particularly respiratory and dermatological problems.

Self-reported work-related symptoms in hairdressers ...

One of the hairdressers' concerns is long-term exposure to chemicals available at work, consisting of potential carcinogenic substances in hair dyes (Babish et al., 1991). WHO considers cosmetology as “probably carcinogenic”; for example, there is a higher risk of bladder cancer in hairdressers (Harling et al., 2010).

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
