Depression; Withdrawal from friends and social activities; Poor (unbelievable) or inconsistent explanations of injuries; Unusual shyness; Avoidance of eye contact with adults or older kids

Some common signs that there may be something concerning happening in a child’s life include: unexplained changes in behaviour or personality, becoming withdrawn, seeming anxious, becoming uncharacteristically aggressive, lacks social skills and has few friends, if any, poor bond or relationship with a parent.

The best available indicator of child physical abuse recorded by the police is offences of violence against the person involving “non-accidental infliction of physical force” where the victim was under the age of 18 ...

Child physical abuse is the non-accidental infliction of physical force on a child. This may involve hitting, shaking, throwing, poisoning, burning or scalding, drowning, suffocating, or otherwise causing physical harm to a child. Physical harm may also be caused when a parent or carer fabricates the symptoms of, or deliberately induces ...

Signs of physical abuse may include: Bruises, welts, or other injuries that can't be explained or don't match with the child's story Burns , especially from cigarettes, that can't be explained

Child Abuse & Neglect: Possible Behavioral Signs ...

Physical problems – the child may develop health problems, including soreness in the genital and anal areas or sexually transmitted infections, or they may become pregnant. Problems at school – an abused child may have difficulty concentrating and learning, and their grades may start to drop.

Emotional abuse | NSPCC

Physical abuse is deliberately hurting or injuring a child. This could be caused by hitting, shaking, throwing, poisoning, burning or scalding, drowning, suffocating or other physical harm. This type of abuse can leave more than physical marks on the body. Physical abuse can make children feel anxious and depressed.
