In 1961, Joe hooked up with veteran wrestler Tom Renesto to form a team called the Assassins, and for the next eleven years, they were considered to be one of wrestling's hottest attractions, drawing sellout crowds to arenas in California, Georgia, Florida, Oklahoma, the Mid-Atlantic, and Washington, in addition to foreign countries like Japan and Australia.
