However it is also noted that according to the Luis Diego Gomez classification system it is seasonal evergreen forest, the last of such remaining in Costa Rica. Some of the birds found here are White-crested Coquette, Long-billed Starthroat, Silver-throated Tanager, Red-legged Honeycreeper, Shining Honeycreeper, and the endemics Orange-collared Manakin, Turquoise Cotinga, Fiery-billed Aracari also Red-headed Barbet and Yellow-bellied Tyrannulet.
