While white households have a median wealth of \$247,500, Dominicans and U.S. blacks have a median wealth of close to zero. Of all nonwhite groups for which estimates could be made, Caribbean black households have the highest median wealth with \$12,000, which is only 5 percent of the wealth attributed to white households in the Boston MSA.

According to recent estimates, black households own just 6.4 percent and Latino households just 7.5 percent of the wealth owned by white households (Sullivan et al. 2015).

White households in Los Angeles have a median net worth of \$355,000. In comparison, Mexicans and U.S. blacks have a median wealth of \$3,500 and \$4,000, respectively. Among nonwhite groups, Japanese (\$592,000), Asian Indian (\$460,000), and Chinese (\$408,200) households had higher median wealth than whites.

A 2013 study found that for white families, every additional dollar they earn in income leads to \$5.19 in wealth. For black families, each dollar creates only sixty-nine cents (\$0.69) in total wealth. ” The Color of Money, page 249-250. Using simple arithmetic: \$5.19 divides by \$0.69 = 7.52.
